Main purpose of job

To learn about printmaking, creative art practice and print studio practice.

Main duties

Technical duties

Work under supervision to complete day-to-day studio maintenance, studio opening and close-down procedures

Administration duties

Complete a time sheet

Create an invoice to HAUSPRINT for work done

Document the work placement (create a visual/ written diary)

Create at least one (as appropriate and agreed) social media post about the work placement

Creative practice duties

Learn how to make and print:

 A linocut - In this relief printing process, an image is carved or etched into a sheet of linoleum. Ink is applied to the lino using a roller; the cut-away areas do not pick up ink. Paper or fabric is placed down onto the image and either printed on a press or printed by hand.

- A monotype Monotype is a way of making a unique print that cannot be repeated. Using methods from painting and drawing, ink is applied to a surface, and marks can be added or taken away from the surface.
- A drypoint Using a sharp pointed tool like an etching needle, an image is scratched into a flat polished sheet of metal, plastic or card.

Evaluate and be able to describe what you have done

The placement will aim to be across 1 week by agreement. You will be reporting to Michelle Avison (Director HAUSPRINT) and Mia Thompson (Technician role).
