Key Responsibilities

Creative Media & Content

Support the creation of digital media for Grooveschool, including short videos, photos, podcasts, DJ content and social media materials. Assist with editing, organising files and contributing ideas for creative output.

Studio Assistance

Help tutors set up and pack down equipment for DJ, podcast and production sessions. Maintain safe, tidy and organised studio spaces. Support young people during workshops under supervision.

Community Projects & Events

Assist with the preparation and delivery of Grooveschool events and programmes. Help document activities and contribute to outreach and engagement tasks.

General Support & Administration

Complete simple admin tasks including progress logs, equipment tracking, scheduling support and basic digital organisation.
