- Keep informed of commissioning needs, priorities and latest marketing trends to inform ideas origination and development opportunities
- Contribute to team brainstorms and discussions on new ideas and ongoing development work
- Support production of any shoots or other filmed materials required for pitch materials or funded requirements
- Attend online and in-person meetings with contributors, agents and other persons of interest alongside the Development Team
- Attend relevant industry briefings, webinars and workshops and take notes to share with the Development Team
- Take part in our weekly Film Club (where we discuss content we have watched)
